Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

### a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

24 HOUR SECURITY  
 KEEPING NUMBER COUNT ON THE PUBLIC WHO ENTER THE MARQUEE/TENT/  
 TIPIS OF THE EVENT WHICH IS SUPPLIED FOR THE CLIENTS ONLY BASED ON THE  
 SIZE OF THE TENTS.  
 FIRE ASSEMBLING ALL EXIT LOCATIONS CLEARLY.  
 HAVING A CONTROLLED DESIGNATED AREAS FOR SMOKING, INS TO BE  
 LOCATED AROUND THE EVENT TO PREVENT TRIP HAZARDS.  
 NOISE LEVELS TO BE KEPT REASONABLE.  
 OUTDOOR LIGHTING FOR GUESTS FOR DARKNESS TO PREVENT ANY TRIPS AND  
 FALLS.  
 PROTECTING CHILDREN DURING THE EVENT BY BEING ABLE TO CLOSE THE  
 GATES OF THE ACCESS TO STOP THEM FROM WANDERING, AND ASKING FOR ID  
 AT THE BAR AT ALL TIMES TO PREVENT SERVING CHILDREN AND UNDER AGE  
 GUESTS ALCOHOL TO PROTECT THEM.  
 ALSO MAKING SURE THAT NO ALCHOL IS IN REACH FOR CHILDREN TO ACCESS  
 WITH OUT PERMISSION AND ID

### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

WE INTEND TO HAVE OUR OWN SECURITY TO PREVENT CRIME AND DISORDER ON THE DAY OF PUTTING UP  
 THE TENT/ DAY OF WEDDING AND TAKING THE EVENT DOWN.  
 STAFF MEETINGS WILL BE HELD TO UPDATE ANYTHING NEW ON THE WAY WE PERFORM OUR WAYS OF  
 REDUCING CRIME AND DISORDER.  
 MAKE SURE THAT THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES KNOW ABOUT THE EVENT PREVIOUSLY SO THAT WE CAN INFORM  
 ALL THEIR PARTNERSHIPS TO REDUCE THE CRIME AND DISORDER.

### c) Public safety

KEEPING COUNT ON HOW MANY PEOPLE ARRIVE IN THE PREMISES AND ONLY  
 ALLOWING THE ALLOWED NUMBER.  
 FIRE ASSEMBLY POINTS SIGNED CLEARLY.  
 A MEETING BEFOE THE EVENT AND MAP DEMONSTRATING TO ALL STAFF  
 MEMBERS IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY THE ASSEMBLY POINT.  
 HAVE DESIGNATED AREAS FOR SMOKING  
 BINS TO BE LOCATED AROUND THE EVENT

### d) The prevention of public nuisance

KEEP NOISE LEVELS DOWN TO APPROPRIATE LEVEL.  
HAVE PLENTY OF OUTDOOR LIGHTING FOR WHEN DARKNESS FALLS TO  
PREVENT ANY HAZARDS FOR THE GUESTS.  
NOISE LIMITERS WILL BE IN PLACE SO THAT THE LIVE MUSIC BANDS DON'T GO  
ABOVE THEIR LIMIT.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

A STATEMENT OF POLICY ON THE ADMISSION OF CHILDREN, STATED.  
ANY AREAS THAT ARE PERMITTED.  
FOR SERVING ALCOHOL, AGE RESTRICTION IS APPLIED AND ID WILL BE ASKED AT ALL TIMES TO  
PREVENT UNDER AGE CHILDREN BEING AT RISK.  
  
ADMISSION OF CHILDREN TO STAY WITH PARENTS AT ALL TIMES AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED  
BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES.  
  
THE GATE CAN BE CLOSED AND LOCKED TO THAT DESIGNATED PRIVATE EVENT IF CHILDREN ARE  
INVITED TO THE EVENT TO PREVENT THEM FROM GOING MISSING.
